

## Child Care Assistant and Early Childhood Educator Classification

Anyone seeking paid employment in a childcare centre in Manitoba may apply for classification. Classification levels are based on completed post-secondary education. Volunteers may also apply for classification. There are three levels in Manitoba:

- Child Care Assistant (CCA)
- Early Childhood Educator II (ECE II)
- Early Childhood Educator III (ECE III).

### RED RIVER COLLEGE WORKPLACE PROGRAM

RRC offers a two-year program that allows you to work for 3 days a week and go to school for two days a week, getting paid full-time, to receive your Level 2 diploma in Early Childhood Education. This program requires you to have worked the equivalent of one year in childcare before applying.

### CCA Opportunities

- Work as a childcare assistant in an infant, preschool, school age centre or nursery school
- Become a home-based childcare provider.
- Upgrade your training to become an ECE.
- Become a substitute or casual staff at a centre or nursery school.
- Work as centre support staff, such as housekeeper, cook.

### ECE II Career Opportunities

- Work as an ECE in an infant, preschool, school age centre or nursery school
- Become a home-based childcare provider.
- Work as a program supervisor
- Become an assistant director or director of a school age centre.
- Become an assistant director or director of a nursery school.

### ECE III Career Opportunities

- Work as an ECE in an infant, preschool, school age centre or nursery school
- Become a home-based childcare provider.
- Work as a program supervisor
- Become an assistant director or director of an infant, preschool or school age centre.
- Become an assistant director or director of a nursery school.
- Work as a child development counsellor (some positions may only require ECE II classification)
